You are invited to submit nominations for the election of the following ISBNPA Executive Committee' positions (see below). **The nominee has to be a ISBNPA member.**

- **President-Elect** (term from June 2018, then President from June 2019 to June 2021)
- **Secretary** (term from June 2018 to June 2021)
- **Two members-at-large** (term from June 2018 to June 2021)
- **One student representative member-at-large** (criteria: up to 12 months after the date of their doctoral degree) (term from June 2018 to June 2020)
- **One early career researcher representative member-at-large** (criteria: who have completed their doctoral degree to the equivalent to full five years) (term from June 2018 to June 2020)

Each voting member of the Society can nominate candidates to be considered by the Nominations Committee in the preparation of the slate of candidates to be submitted for ballot in November 2017. The nominee must be a **member of ISBNPA at that time.**

Individuals receiving the highest number of nominations will be asked to confirm they accept the nomination and will be asked complete a letter of motivation. The Nominating Committee may place the name of additional qualified candidates of its choice on the ballot as well.

In keeping with the **international** basis of the ISBNPA and its focus on **behavioral nutrition and physical activity**, we expect that you will consider these two important aspects in making your nominations.

As you think about your proposed nomination(s), please consider that service on the ISBNPA Executive Committee requires a commitment of time, talent, energy and creativity to advance our goals and mission. The rewards are enormous. EC leadership positions bring opportunities to make a lasting difference for our members and for the fields we serve. Self-nominations are accepted.
